SEMICON Southeast Asia Penang 2017

On 25 April 2017, K-One's digital hub initiative - KiasuLab participated in the 2017 SEMICON Southeast Asia (SEA) Exhibition in Penang, Malaysia. The exhibition was officially launched by our Minister of International Trade & Industry, Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed. This marked a very important milestone on our journey to create an exciting and innovative start-up community for our first revolutionary co-working space located at our HQ in Petaling Jaya, Malaysia. It also has a tripartite arrangement with Cradle Fund, an agency under the Ministry of Finance Incorporated and the Malaysian Business Angel Network to share information on start-ups and identify high potential ones for possible investment.
